- Offer to help with the preparations – help lay the table, Help clear up after the meals
- Make sure you talk to your hosts and their guests at meals.
- It is considered rude if you don't
- Let them know that you like the food and the activities they have arranged

Christmas Gifts

- Students will almost certainly get gifts for Christmas from their hosts, and you should always thank them
- Small gifts for your hosts should be considered for example a bunch of seasonal flowers, a Christmas potted plant or chocolates





The normal Do's and Don'ts especially apply at Christmas

Do's

- Do be polite & friendly – saying please and thank you are important when your family provides something for you.
- Do get involved with family activities
- Do keep your room and bathroom clean and tidy
- Do keep to your Host Family Rules – these will be explained on arrival
- Do keep in touch with your family before, during & after your stay



Don'ts

- Don't stay in your room all the time
- Don't be late getting up or for meals
- Don't be noisy late at night
- Don't take a bath or shower for too long or at unreasonable times
- Don't spend excessive time on games on line
- Don't watch inappropriate material from the internet
